Our Purpose:

DenverWorks believes we serve a God of second chances. Since opening our doors in 1995 our staff has been committed to empowering their clients to find meaningful employment and receive a second chance at becoming all that God intended them to be. Work is honorable and essential in providing for oneself and one's family. As the number of people in need continues to grow so does our commitment to provide more hope to more people.

Our Mission:

DenverWorks' mission is to empower jobseekers to fulfill their God-given design through preparation for employment leading to self-sufficiency.

Our Programs:

The Employment Ready Program equips jobseekers for a successful employment search. Clients attend a half-day jobseeker workshop and are then matched with a client manager who provides individualized job search assistance to include career counseling, resume preparation, community voicemail and e-mail setup, interview coaching, job leads, and community referrals.

The 2nd Chance Program provides employment assistance to the prisoner reentry population.

Clients attend a half-day former offender workshop and then receive services specific to the needs of former offenders. 2nd Chance offers job leads, a computer lab, mentoring opportunities, and other support services. Our goal is to provide the skills necessary for a successful reentry.



Workshops:

The jobseeker workshop provides valuable training in job search strategies, interviewing skills, understanding today's business culture, and overcoming barriers to employment. The former offender workshop focuses on job search strategies for former offenders, tips on responding to difficult interview questions, and industries and employers who are felon-friendly.



The Women@Work and Men@Work Clothing Closets:

Clothing closets provide jobseekers with up to five outfits for interviewing and on-the-job confidence. Nearly 100 community agencies refer their clients to DenverWorks to receive free work attire.



Mentoring:

Partners for Success provides one-on-one mentoring to DenverWorks clients. Individual mentoring creates support and accountability as clients overcome barriers and obtain and retain employment.

Life Skills Group Mentoring is designed to teach former offenders critical life skills that will empower them to become contributing members of their communities. It is offered in a group setting at DenverWorks' office.

First 48 Out of the Gate is offered in select Colorado prisons to offenders who are six months or less from release. This program is held in group settings and teaches a variety of life skills essential for a successful reentry into society.



Computer Lab:

DenverWorks' computer lab is available for jobseekers on a drop-in basis. Volunteers may assist users with e-mail accounts, resumes, and online applications.
