OUR MISSION

DenverWorks' mission is to empower jobseekers to fulfill their God-given design through preparation for employment.

OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Since 1995, DenverWorks has:

- served **15,334** individuals in Metro Denver
- provided client management services to **6,415** adults, resulting in **3,801** jobs
- trained **2,579** at-risk and incarcerated youth in job readiness skills
- received a federal grant in 2005 through the Denver Metro Prisoner Re-entry Initiative to provide former offenders with reintegration and employment services; grant renewed for 2007-08
- created over **225** relationships with employers

OUR PROGRAMS

EMPLOYMENT READY

One-on-one client consultation is the core of our *Employment Ready Program*. Clients who have completed the Jobseeker Workshop are matched with a client manager who will provide individualized job search assistance to include career counseling, resume preparation, community voicemail and e-mail setup, interview coaching, job leads, and community referrals. Our goal is to equip jobseekers for a successful employment search.

2ND CHANCE

The *2nd Chance Program* was created to provide employment assistance to the prisoner reentry population. The entry point into the program is the Former Offender Workshop. Topics of the workshop include job search strategies for former offenders, tips on responding to difficult interview questions, and industries and employers who are felon-friendly. *2nd Chance* offers job leads, clothing, a computer lab, mentoring opportunities, and other assistance based on qualifying criteria. Our goal is to provide the skills necessary for a successful reentry.



OUR SERVICES

JOBSEEKER WORKSHOPS

The Jobseeker Workshop provides valuable training in assessment of employment barriers, job search strategies, business culture, and interviewing skills. The Former Offender Workshop includes job search strategies specific to former offenders.

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES FOR SPANISH SPEAKERS

To accommodate our Spanish-speaking clients (with limited or no English skills), we offer job leads and community referrals in Spanish.

WOMEN@WORK AND MEN@WORK CLOTHING CLOSETS

DenverWorks provides jobseekers with up to five outfits for interviewing and on-the-job confidence. Over 100 community agencies refer their clients to DenverWorks to receive free work attire.

PARTNERS FOR SUCCESS

In collaboration with DenverWorks, Volunteers in Action provides mentors to support clients in building life skills and retaining employment.

COMPUTER LAB

DenverWorks' computer lab is available for jobseekers on a drop-in basis. Volunteers may assist users with e-mail accounts, resumes, keyboard tutorials, and online applications.
