DenverWorks serves former offenders through our 2nd Chance program.

Why Hire a Former Offender?

You may ask, "Why would I hire someone with a criminal background? I am not willing to take a risk when I can find an employee with a clean record."

In Colorado, one in four adults have either a misdemeanor or felony conviction in his or her past.

Our employers report that the former offenders they have hired are often their hardest working employees. Former offenders recognize the gift of being able to prove themselves worthy of a second chance.

You are protected!

Some employers may be hesitant to hire former offenders because of liability issues. Former offenders are bondable up to \$5,000 at *no cost to the employer*. The bond protects employers against theft, fraud, forgery, larceny, and similar events. It is good for six months and renewable for another six months. Access this website for more information:
